On August 15, 2007, AmerenUE contractors began undergrounding work on the power lines along Barrett Woods Drive, which deliver power to your home. Placing these lines under ground will protect them from high winds, ice, and falling trees and branches. This power line has been particularly vulnerable to outages during major storms in the past.

You may or may not see the undergrounding work, but all homes served by this circuit – and other connecting circuits slated for undergrounding – will benefit from this initiative. You can track the progress of this project on our Web site. [www.ameren.com/poweron](http://www.ameren.com/poweron)

This undergrounding work is part of AmerenUE's *Project Power On*, a three-year, \$1 billion initiative to improve service reliability, upgrade our power delivery systems, and enhance the environmental performance of our power plants in Missouri. Through *Project Power On*, AmerenUE is investing \$300 million to underground circuits most susceptible to outages – particularly during severe weather. The company is also spending more than \$200 million on additional tree trimming and system inspection efforts.
