On March 19, 2009, Kansas City Power and Light Company and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company filed a motion for reconsideration of the Commission's order modifying the True-Up procedural schedule. The Companies also requested expedited treatment so that all of the parties will know the parameters of the True-Up as soon as possible. Because the Commission needs to consider the motions expeditiously, the Commission shall set a time for expeditious responses.

1. Any party wishing to respond to Kansas City Power and Light Company's and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company's March 19, 2009 pleading entitled "Motion for Reconsideration and/or Rehearing of Order Modifying Procedural Schedules for True-

Up Proceedings and Motion for Expedited Treatment shall file its response no later than 2:00 p.m. on Monday, March 23, 2009.
