ORDER GRANTING LEAVE TO APPEAR *PRO HAC VICE*

On February 5, 2009, Arthur Perry Bruder, Esq., filed a petition for leave to appear *pro hac vice* as one of the attorneys for intervenors United States Department of Energy, United States Nuclear Security Administration, and all other affected Federal Executive Agencies (collectively, "Federal Executive Agencies"). Mr. Bruder is admitted to practice before the courts of the state of New York but is not admitted to practice before Missouri courts. He has designated Mark W. Comley, a member in good standing of the Missouri Bar, as local counsel. The petition includes proof of compliance with Missouri Supreme Court Rule 6.01(m).

The Commission has considered the petition and finds that it complies with the requirements of 4 CSR 240-2.040(3)(C) and Missouri Supreme Court Rules 6.01(m) and 9.03. The Commission therefore admits Arthur Perry Bruder *pro hac vice* to appear on behalf of the Federal Executive Agencies.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Petition of Arthur Perry Bruder for Leave to Appear *Pro Hac Vice* is granted.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
