2 (Whereupon, the public hearing started at 10:00
3 A.M.)

4 JUDGE BUSHMANN: Okay. Let's go on the record.
5 Good morning. Today is January 20, 2017, ten o'clock A.M.
6 The Commission has set this time for a Rulemaking Hearing
7 for In the Matter of the Proposed Amendment of the
8 Commission's Rules Relating to Natural Gas Safety, File
9 No. GX-2016-0263.

10 My name is Michael Bushmann. I'm the Regulatory
11 Law Judge presiding over this hearing. Since this is a
12 Rulemaking Hearing and not a contested case, there's no
13 need to swear in witnesses or take entries of appearance.
14 If you'd like to provide a comment to the Commission, you
15 just need to raise your hand. I'll ask you to state your
16 name for the record and who you represent.

17 Mr. Williams, I believe that there's no one
18 besides Staff here, so I'll ask you to go ahead and you
19 can say who you are for the record and who you represent.

20 MR. WILLIAMS: Thank you, Judge. My name is
21 Hampton Williams. I represent the Public Service
22 Commission and have provided my information, contact
23 information, to the reporter. I just have one comment.

24 On Tuesday of this week, Staff entered a comment
25 into this file. At the end of the first paragraph, we

1 erroneously cite the case number. It reads GX-2016-0092.
 2 It should read GX-2016-0263. Also, just to put it on the
 3 record, on Wednesday, at this week's agenda, Chairman Hall
 4 did articulate that this rulemaking proceeding is in
 5 conformance with Governor Greitens' Executive Order 1703.
 6 We have communicated to the Governor's office the
 7 existence of this rulemaking and we have received
 8 permission to continue with it. That will be all. Thank
 9 you.

10 MR. KEEVIL: Did you hear about that case? It's
 11 13-0092, isn't it?

12 MR. WILLIAMS: The correct number should be this
 13 one.

14 MR. KEEVIL: Should be what?

15 MR. WILLIAMS: Should be 0263.

16 MR. KEEVIL: Okay.

17 MR. WILLIAMS: That was the incorrect one.

18 JUDGE BUSHMANN: Any other comments by Staff?

19 MR. WILLIAMS: I believe that Jeff had corrected
 20 me on my correction. The incorrect number is the 2016.
 21 It should read 2013-0092. The citation is to address the
 22 previous rulemaking that we had engaged in, not the
 23 current rulemaking.

24 JUDGE BUSHMANN: Okay. And that's the last
 25 sentence on the first paragraph?

1 MR. WILLIAMS: Yes, sir.

2 JUDGE BUSHMANN: Okay. Very good. With that, I
3 don't think there's any other comments that we need to
4 receive, so this hearing is adjourned. We're off the
5 record.


