For Laclede's failure to comply with the Commission's order, the Commission will direct Laclede to file a pleading stating why the Commission should not direct its General Counsel to seek all remedies available under Missouri law.

1. Laclede Gas Company shall file, no later than February 13, 2010, a pleading as set out in the body of this order.

2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
