### STAFF RECOMMENDATION IN THIS CASE

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission in the abovecaptioned matter and, in response to the tariff filed by Laclede to increase its PGA for the remaining winter season, states:

 On February 28, 2005, Laclede Gas Company (Laclede or Company) of St. Louis, Missouri, filed a tariff sheet proposed to become effective March 14, 2005.

2. The tariff sheet was filed to reflect scheduled changes in Laclede's Purchased Gas Adjustment (PGA) factors as the result of an estimated change in the cost of natural gas for the remaining winter season.

3. Unlike other local distribution companies in the state, Laclede's winter season includes the month of April.

4. The Commission's Energy Department Staff (Staff) has reviewed this filing and has determined that the rates on the proposed tariff sheet were calculated in conformance with Laclede's PGA Clause.

5. Laclede has requested expedited treatment and Staff is of the opinion that good cause for approval of this tariff sheet on less than thirty (30) days notice is demonstrated by Laclede's Commission approved PGA Clause allowing for ten (10) business days notice for PGA change filings.

6. The rates should be approved interim subject to refund only.

WHEREFORE, the Staff recommends that the Commission approve Laclede's requested

tariff change to be effective on March 14, 2005, interim subject to refund only.

SUBJECT: Staff Recommendation on Laclede Gas Company's Scheduled Winter Season PGA Filing Effective March 14, 2005
DATE: March 7, 2005

On February 28, 2005, Laclede Gas Company (Laclede or Company) of St. Louis, Missouri, filed a tariff sheet proposed to become effective March 14, 2005. The tariff sheet was filed to reflect scheduled changes in Laclede's Purchased Gas Adjustment (PGA) factors as the result of an estimated change in the cost of natural gas for the remaining winter season. Laclede's winter season was set in their last rate case to include the months of November through April. All other Local Distribution Companies have a winter period of November through March.

The net effect of these changes will increase the firm PGA factor to \$0.77260 per therm from the firm PGA factor of \$0.70996 per therm currently in effect. This proposal would increase a typical residential customer's bill approximately \$16, or 2% for the remainder of the 2004-2005 winter season, when compared to the rates currently in effect.

Case No. GR-2005-0203, under which these changes were filed, was established to track the Company's PGA factors to be reviewed in its 2004-2005 Actual Cost Adjustment (ACA) filing. Case Nos. GR-2003-0224 and GR-2004-0273 were established to track the Company's PGA factors to be reviewed in its 2002-2003 and 2003-2004 ACA filings, respectively. Interim subject to refund status should be maintained pending final Commission decisions in ACA Case Nos. GR-2003-0224, GR-2004-0273, and GR-2005-0203.

The Commission's Energy Department Staff (Staff) has reviewed this filing and has determined that the rates on the proposed tariff sheet were calculated in conformance with Laclede's PGA Clause. Staff is of the opinion that good cause for approval of this tariff sheet on less than thirty (30) days notice is demonstrated by Laclede's Commission approved PGA Clause allowing for ten (10) business days notice for PGA change filings. The Staff has verified that the Company has filed its Appendix A

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annual report and is not delinquent on any assessment. The Staff has reviewed this filing and is unaware of any issue currently pending before the Commission that affects or is affected by this filing; however, the following cases involving this Company are open:

## REMARKS

For a residential customer using approximately 255 therms for the remainder of the winter season (March - April), natural gas rates will increase by approximately \$16 or approximately 2% when comparing the fuel bills for the current remaining winter season before and after the scheduled winter filing.
