**ORDER GIVING NOTICE OF DEFICIENCY AND NON-COMPLIANCE
WITH COMMISSION ORDER**

Effective Date: July 19, 2010

On December 1, 2009, the Commission directed Trigen-Kansas City Energy Corporation (“Trigen”) to file quarterly status reports regarding the completion of construction and all associated costs, payments and reimbursements related to the expansion of its service to Truman Medical Center. The status reports were to be filed beginning January 1, 2010. Trigen was late with filing the status reports due in January and April and has still not filed the required quarterly status report that was due on July 1, 2010, despite a phone reminder from the Regulatory Law Judge. Consequently, the Commission gives notice that Trigen is deficient with complying with the Commission’s order.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Trigen-Kansas City Energy Corporation is currently in non-compliance with the Commission’s December 1, 2009 “Order Granting Staff’s Request To Keep File Open And Directing Status Reports From Trigen-Kansas City Energy Corporation.”
2. Trigen-Kansas City Energy Corporation shall cure its filing deficiencies not later than July 26, 2010.

3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
