1. All construction of the extension of Veolia’s¹ facilities to serve the Truman Medical Center (“Truman”) is completed;
2. The total construction costs of the extension of Veolia’s facilities to serve Truman has been charged to Truman;
3. All construction costs for which Truman is responsible have been fully reimbursed to Veolia.
4. This Final Report is consistent with the attachments to Veolia’s filings made on July 31, 2008 and September 15, 2008 where the total construction costs are identified along with the total Truman reimbursements.
