ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTIONS AND
SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On January 10, 2006, Trigen-Kansas City Energy Corporation filed an Application and, among other requests, filed a Motion requesting a prehearing conference. Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCPL) and Missouri Gas Energy (MGE) timely sought intervention by filing Applications to Intervene.

The Commission finds that KCPL and MGE have substantially complied with Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(4) in that they have interests in this matter that are different from those of the general public and that granting these interventions would serve the public interest. The Commission also finds that no party filed an objection to KCPL's and MGE's interventions.

Truman Medical Center also seeks to intervene, having filed an Application to Intervene Out of Time for Good Cause. The Commission will rule on this motion in due course and before the time set herein for the prehearing conference.

The Commission will schedule a prehearing conference for the parties to discuss the schedule by which the Commission will proceed to hear Trigen's Application.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Applications to Intervene filed by Kansas City Power & Light and Missouri Gas Energy are granted.

2. A prehearing conference shall be held on March 9, 2006, beginning at 10:00 a.m., in the Governor Office Building, Room 305, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. The conference will be held in a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act.
