Request for Clarifications, Osage Valley Electric Cooperative Association

Osage Valley respectfully requests that the Commission refer the following questions to Ms. Hertzog with direction to file or provide Osage Valley the answers to the following questions by May 10, 2012:

- 1. With respect to item 1 on Ms. Hertzog's undated "To Whom it May Concern" letter attached with respect to paragraph 5 of her application, Ms. Hertzog says ".... her property was initially serviced by Osage Valley but has subsequently changed", please answer or explain the following:
 - a. is this referring to your residential property or a commercial property?
 - if you have more than one commercial property, please describe which commercial property you are referring to.
 - c. who provides electric service to this property now?
 - d. who provided electric service to this property prior to the change?

- e. are you requesting that the Commission approve a change in electric suppliers for this property?
- 2. With respect to item 2 on Ms. Hertzog's undated "To Whom it May Concern" letter attached with respect to paragraph 5 of her application, Ms. Hertzog says "I have commercial property with substantial electric bills. KCP&L has an incentive for Solar Energy that Osage Valley does not have therefore reducing my electric bills, useage and alleviating my current financial burden of the property since selling my main company in an expensive divorce", please answer or explain the following:
 - a. Please describe the commercial properties you are referring to.
 - b. Please specify which property was sold in or pursuant to a divorce.
 - c. Please specify by name and address to whom the property sold in or pursuant to a divorce was sold to.
 - d. For each property state who is the present electric power supplier.
 - e. For each property state if you are requesting a change of supplier to KCP&L.
 - f. Please describe the solar energy incentive provided by KCP&L, and attach copies of any documents you have describing this incentive.
 - g. Please describe your solar energy generation plans.
 - h. Please describe your solar energy purchase plans.
 - Please explain your current financial burden of the property, and how changing power suppliers would affect that burden.
 - j. Please provide your analysis, and provide copies of it if in writing, as to how utilizing the solar energy incentive would reduce your electric bills.

- 3. With respect to item 4 on Ms. Hertzog's undated "To Whom it May Concern" letter attached with respect to paragraph 5 of her application, Ms. Hertzog says "If solar is utilized this will be more environmentally friendly", please answer or explain the following:
 - a. Who would be generating the solar energy you refer to?
 - b. Who would be consuming the solar energy you refer to?
 - c. Who would be purchasing the solar energy you refer to?
 - d. Please explain what energy you are comparing to solar energy when you say the solar energy "will be more environmentally friendly".
