On November 17, 2021, Ronald E. Taylor filed a formal complaint with the Commission against Spire Missouri Inc. d/b/a Spire. On December 22, 2021, Spire filed its *Answer*. On January 18, 2022, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed its investigative *Staff Report*.

Having received Mr. Taylor’s complaint, Spire’s answer, and Staff’s investigative report, this matter is ready to proceed.
