ORDER APPROVING TARIFFS IN COMPLIANCE WITH COMMISSION ORDER

On January 13, 2004, the Commission approved the parties' Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement. That stipulation requires AmerenUE to implement the Energy Efficient Natural Gas Rebate Program.

On December 23, 2004, AmerenUE filed tariff sheets to implement that program.

The Commission approved those tariffs for service on and after February 1, 2005.

On August 31, 2005, AmerenUE filed tariff sheets to modify its funding of that program. The tariff sheets are due to become effective on October 1, 2005. On September 16, 2005, the Staff of the Commission filed its Recommendation. Staff stated that the tariff sheets comply with the stipulation and the Commission's order, and recommended that the Commission approve them.

The Commission has reviewed the tariff filings, the Stipulation and Agreement, and the Staff Recommendation. The Commission determines that the tariff sheets comply with the agreement and with the Commission's order.
