On December 29, 2005, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed

its recommendation for Actual Cost Adjustment balance disallowances for Laclede Gas

Company's 2003-2004 ACA period. In addition, Staff set out several other recommenda-

tions. Laclede responded on February 27, 2006. Following negotiations and a technical

conference, the Staff informed the Commission on August 24, 2006, that only the issue of

swing supply demand charges remained contested. The Commission held an evidentiary

hearing on that matter.

In order for the Commission to set the ACA balances and direct any follow-up

with regard to Staff's other recommendations, the Commission needs to be apprised of the

actual numbers which were agreed to. Therefore, the Commission will direct its Staff to file

a supplemental recommendation stating which recommendations remain outstanding and

what ACA balances should be set with or without a disallowance for swing supply demand

charges.

The Commission will also set out a time for the other parties to respond.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. No later than June 14, 2007, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file a supplemental recommendation stating which recommendations remain outstanding and what ACA balances should be set with or without a disallowance for swing supply demand charges.
- 2. Responses to Staff's supplemental recommendation shall be filed no later than June 20, 2007.
 - 3. This order shall become effective on June 7, 2007.
