## **ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE RECOMMENDATION**

On July 13, 2009, Missouri Gas Energy, a division of Southern Union Company (MGE), filed an application seeking an Accounting Authority Order authorizing deferred accounting treatment for new Kansas property taxes on natural gas stored in that state. On July 14, the Commission issued an order directing that notice of MGE's application be given to potentially interested parties, and established August 4 as the deadline for the filing of applications to intervene. That date has now passed and no application to intervene has been filed.

Before acting on MGE's application, the Commission will require a recommendation from its Staff. The Commission will also establish a date by which interested parties may respond to Staff's recommendation.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Staff shall file a recommendation regarding Missouri Gas Energy's Application for an Accounting Authority Order no later than September 8, 2009.

2. Any party that wants to respond to Staff's recommendation shall do so no later than ten calendar days after Staff files its recommendation.

3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
