On October 21, 2005, the Office of the Public Counsel petitioned the Commission to open the above-captioned case. On October 25, 2005, the case was opened. Written comments were received, a technical conference was held on November 10, 2005, and a hearing was held on December 2, 2005. On December 12, 2005, Ms. Jacqueline A. Hutchinson filed Comments on the Emergency Amendment to the Cold Weather Rule. In its approval of the Emergency Amendment on December 13, 2005, the Commission addressed only the first of four suggested amendments suggested by Ms. Hutchinson.

As the Commission noted during its Agenda Session, it will continue its review of the Cold Weather Rule to determine whether further emergency modifications are necessary and appropriate. In order to do so in a timely manner, the Commission requires that all participants in this matter shall file, on or before December 16, 2005, responses in support of or against suggestions two, three and four, set out in Ms. Hutchinson's letter, together with such reasoning and underlying documentation as can be gathered in the allotted time.

That interested persons shall file, on or before December 16, 2005, responses in support of or against suggestions two, three and four set out in Ms. Hutchinson's Comment Letter of December 12, 2005, together with such reasoning and underlying documentation as can be gathered in the allotted time.
