**ORDER REVISING HEARING SCHEDULE**

Effective Date: November 4, 2008

The evidentiary hearing for this case is scheduled to begin on November 17, 2008, and continue through November 21, 24-25 and December 1-5. On October 29, the Staff of the Commission filed a motion suggesting that the Commission delay the start of the hearing until November 20. To compensate for the lost hearing time, Staff asks the Commission to add three hearing days on December 10, 11, and 12. Staff's motion represents that it contacted all the other parties about the proposed schedule change and that no one objected to the change.

On October 31, the Commission ordered that any party wishing to respond to Staff's motion do so no later than November 3. AmerenUE filed a response supporting Staff's motion on November 3. No other party responded. Given the apparent agreement of the parties, the Commission will modify the hearing schedule as recommended by Staff.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The hearing schedule is modified to provide that the hearing shall commence on November 20, 2008, at 8:30 a.m. The hearing shall continue on November 21, 24 and 25, December 1-5, and December 10, 11, and 12, 2008.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
