## ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT FOR FAILURE TO RESPOND TO COMMISSION ORDER

Issue Date: January 22. 2014 Effective Date: February 21, 2014

The Missouri Public Service Commission issued an order setting a prehearing conference, which was held on November 22, 2013. Lynn Gray, Complainant, failed to appear. On December 5, the Commission issued an order directing Complainant to file, no later than December 20, 2013, a statement showing good cause for her failure to appear.

In that order, the Commission explained that under its rules<sup>1</sup> this complaint maybe dismissed because Complainant failed show good cause for missing the prehearing conference or for not responding to a Commission order. Complainant has not responded to the Commission's order setting forth good cause for having failed to attend the prehearing conference.

Because Complainant has not responded to the Commission's order, the Commission will dismiss this complaint.
