### ORDER SETTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Issue Date: August 31, 2016 Effective Date: August 31, 2016

On August 25, 2016, the parties filed alternative procedural schedules. Laclede Gas Company and Missouri Gas Energy ("Respondents") filed a schedule to which the Missouri Division of Energy agreed ("Respondents' schedule"). Respondents' schedule would have the Commission hold a hearing in March, 2017, with briefs due in April and May, 2017.

Also on August 25, 2016, the Office of the Public Counsel ("OPC"), Consumers Council of Missouri ("CCOM"), the Missouri Energy Consumers Group ("MECG"), and Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers ("MIEC") filed their own schedule ("OPC's schedule"). OPC's schedule would have the Commission hold a hearing in January, 2017, with briefs due in February, 2017, and a Report and Order due in March, 2017.

As the complainant, OPC has the burden of proof.<sup>1</sup> Further, the Commission is mindful of the rate case Respondents must file by April 2017. If the Commission finds in favor of Respondents' schedule but ultimately finds in favor of OPC on the merits of the case, any change in rates due to that decision would have very little effect. Thus, the Commission will adopt OPC's proposed timeline.<sup>2</sup>
