On May 18, 2020, Spire Missouri Inc. (Spire) filed the above-referenced application. The Commission issued notice, and received intervention requests from Midwest Energy Consumers Group, Renew Missouri, Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers, and the National Housing Trust. Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.080(13) allows parties ten days to respond to pleadings unless otherwise ordered by the Commission. The Commission issued no order to the contrary of that rule, more than ten days have elapsed since the applications to intervene, and no party has objected. Thus, the Commission will take up the applications for intervention unopposed.
