- 2. The tariff sheet was filed to reflect scheduled changes in Laclede's Purchased Gas Adjustment (PGA) factors as the result of an estimated change in the cost of natural gas for the remaining winter season.
- 3. On October 31, 2004, Laclede Gas Company (Laclede or Company) filed a tariff sheet to adjust its charges for natural gas which it proposed to become effective November 15, 2004.
- 4. The Procurement Analysis Department (Staff) reviewed Laclede's 2003-2004 Actual Cost Adjustment (ACA) filing and the results of Staff's analysis were filed in its *Staff Memorandum* on December 29, 2005.
- 5. Staff and the Company have met in informal technical conferences in an attempt to reach a better understanding of Laclede's gas purchasing decisions.
- 6. As a result of these technical conferences, Staff's recommended adjustment concerning ** ______ ** is no longer an issue in this Purchased Gas Adjustment case.
