In various pleadings, including the Office of the Public Counsel's motion for reconsideration and request for clarification filed on May 4, 2009, the PSC Staff's reply to Laclede's response to their motion for reconsideration filed on May 21, and Public Counsel's response and motion to reject Laclede's request for a special agenda meeting filed on May 28, Staff and OPC have referred to provisions a Stipulation and Agreement in Commission Case No. GM-2001-342. Staff and OPC argue that Laclede is bound by this agreement to disclose the records of its unregulated affiliates as part of their discovery requests seeking Laclede's compliance with certain commitments made by Laclede in that case. Laclede Gas responded with a June 2, pleading urging the Commission to reject these arguments as "impermissible, meritless and moot."

The Commission will require Laclede, Staff and OPC to further explain their positions that Section III, numbered paragraph 8, and Section IV, numbered paragraph 1 of this Stipulation and Agreement either operate or do not operate to require Laclede to provide the requested information. The parties are further directed to include any citations to rules

or case law that supports their position, to the Commission why the agreement does or does not bind Laclede to provide the information sought.
