ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

The Commission is ordering Charles Harter to show cause why the Commission should not dismiss Mr. Harter's complaint for failure to state a claim on which relief may be granted. Charles Harter's complaint¹ and reply² cite provisions of law; but either describe no violation of, or cite no Commission authority to enforce, such provisions. The Commission will order Mr. Harter, and permit other parties, to file a response to this order.

1. No later than April 14, 2016, Charles Harter shall file a response to this order showing cause why the Commission should not dismiss the complaint for failure to state a claim on which relief may be granted.
2. Any other party may file a response to this order no later than April 14, 2016.
