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- 2 HEARING OFFICER VOSS: Good morning, we're
- 3 here for a pre-hearing conference in Commission Case
- 4 No. GC-2007-0442, in the matter of Irene D'Souza
- 5 versus Union Electric Company doing business as
- 6 AmerenUE.
- 7 I'm Cheryln Voss, I'm the Regulatory Law Judge
- 8 assigned to hear this case. I will be presiding over
- 9 this pre-hearing conference due to the assigned Judge,
- 10 Benjamin Lane, being ill.
- We're going to begin with entries of appearance
- 12 beginning with Miss D'Souza.
- Just state and spell and your name and your
- 14 mailing address, please.
- 15 MS. D'SOUZA: I-R-E-N-E, D-S-O-U-Z-A, 3708
- 16 West Rollins Road, Columbia, Missouri 65203.
- 17 HEARING OFFICER VOSS: Thank you.
- Now we'll go with Ameren.
- 19 MR. LOWERY: Good morning, Your Honor. My
- 20 name is Jim Lowery, I'm with Smith Lewis, L.L.P, P.O.
- 21 Box 918, Columbia, Missouri 65205 entering my
- 22 appearance on behalf of AmerenUE.
- MS. D'SOUZA: I'm having a hard time
- 24 hearing you.
- 25 HEARING OFFICER VOSS: That's fine, that

- 1 was the attorney for Ameren giving his name and
- 2 address. We'll do that a couple more times. And when
- 3 I leave, I'll tell you. And then, whatever you all
- 4 need to do to make sure you hear everything, you can
- 5 do. Now, we're --
- 6 MS. D'SOUZA: I can hear the gentleman
- 7 better than I can hear you.
- 8 HEARING OFFICER VOSS: Yes, we are on a
- 9 speaker phone and have the speakers up very loud. He
- 10 is on a regular phone.
- So, we're going to have Staff take their entry
- 12 now.
- MS. SHEMWELL: Lera Shemwell representing
- 14 the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission,
- 15 Post Office Box 360, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102,
- 16 with Sarah Kliethermes, same address.
- 17 HEARING OFFICER VOSS: The Office of the
- 18 Public Counsel.
- 19 MR. POSTON: Marc Poston appearing for the
- 20 Office of the Public Counsel, P.O. Box 2230, Jefferson
- 21 City, Missouri 65102.
- 22 HEARING OFFICER VOSS: That concludes the
- 23 things we need to discuss on the on-the-record
- 24 presentation. Now I will leave, and the court
- 25 reporter will leave, and this will allow the parties a

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1 chance to discuss settlement, or to determine what

- 2 steps they want to proceed with in this case.
- 3 Irene?
- 4 MS. D'SOUZA: Yes.
- 5 HEARING OFFICER VOSS: It was a pleasure to
- 6 talk to you. If you have trouble hearing, which is a
- 7 very good possibility, just speak up and let them
- 8 know. And hopefully Jennifer will be able to
- 9 interpret for you to some extent when you can't hear.
- 10 MS. SHIKLES: Yes.
- 11 HEARING OFFICER VOSS: And I understand
- 12 that Judge Lane has set September 11th as the date
- 13 when a procedural schedule needs to be filed.
- MS. SHIKLES: Irene, September 11 is when a
- 15 procedural -- I'm sorry, what was it?
- 16 HEARING OFFICER VOSS: A procedural
- 17 schedule. Basically, if the complaint doesn't
- 18 settle --
- MS. D'SOUZA: September 8?
- MS. SHIKLES: September 11.
- 21 MS. D'SOUZA: The final conference hearing?
- 22 HEARING OFFICER VOSS: No, that's the date
- 23 you have to decide when that hearing will be, if you
- 24 need one. Ms. Shemwell will make sure that you
- 25 understand the dates.

1	MS. D'SOUZA: OKay.
2	HEARING OFFICER VOSS: And this is not
3	going to be an evidentiary hearing, everyone can speak
4	freely. These are settlement negotiations, and the
5	comments just pertain to settling. We won't have
6	anything on the record at this point.
7	This concludes the on-the-record presentation.
8	I'm going to leave. Everyone has my number if they
9	need to get ahold of me.
10	I want to let you know real quickly, Ms. D'Souza,
11	who is here on the phone. There is a representative
12	from the Staff of the Commission and the Office of the
13	Public Counsel which is the People's advocate
14	and the company. So, there are four different parties
15	on the line with you, including you. Okay?
16	MS. D'SOUZA: Okay.
