ORDER MODIFYING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On May 24, 2005, the Commission adopted a procedural schedule regarding the complaint filed by the County of Jackson, Missouri, against Trigen-Kansas City and Thermal North America, Inc. That procedural schedule requires the parties to file position statements on October 11, 2005. In light of the recently modified procedures used by the Commission in other cases, the Commission will modify the procedural schedule to provide that instead of position statements, the parties shall file pre-hearing briefs on October 11.

Each party's pre-hearing brief shall explain that party's position on each disputed issue. Such brief shall set out the facts that the party believes will support its position, as

well as the legal theory supporting that position. The schedule for filing a post-hearing brief will be determined at the hearing.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the procedural schedule previously established for this case is modified to provide that the parties shall file pre-hearing briefs on October 11, 2005, instead of position statements.

2. That this order shall become effective on July 1, 2005.
