#### ORDER SETTING PROCEDURAL CONFERENCE

On March 30, 2018, Locustwood Associates filed a complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") against Spire Missouri d/b/a Spire. April 4, 2018, Notice of the formal complaint was issued and the Commission's Staff was ordered to file a report and recommendation by May 21, 2018. On May 22, 2018, an order appointing a mediator was issued, suspending the case under Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.125(2)(C).

The Commission finds that a procedural conference is now appropriate to discuss filing deadlines for a procedural schedule and a date for an evidentiary hearing. The parties or their representatives shall appear in person or by telephone at the conference, unless excused by the regulatory law judge.
