ORDER ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On November 6, 2020, Vearline Nelson filed two complaints with the Missouri Public Service Commission against Spire Missouri Inc., d/b/a Spire. The Commission consolidated those complaints under the above file number on December 4, 2020. The Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed its report regarding the complaints on February 26, 2021, subsequently, the Commission ordered Staff to file a proposed procedural schedule on behalf of the parties.

On March 17, 2021, Staff filed a joint proposed procedural schedule on behalf of Staff and Spire. Staff made multiple attempts to contact Ms. Nelson to discuss the procedural schedule, but was unable to contact her.

The Commission will adopt Staff and Spire's proposed procedural schedule, but will add a prehearing conference to ascertain that Ms. Nelson is able, and wants, to participate in the evidentiary hearing via telephone.
