Constellation NewEnergy Gas Division, LLC filed a complaint against Spire Missouri Inc. d/b/a Spire on March 26, 2021, regarding Operational Flow Order penalties following a cold weather event in February 2021. On April 28, 2021, Spire filed its answer and a motion to dismiss the complaint for failure to state a claim upon which relief can be granted. The Commission will establish a time for the filing of responses to that motion to dismiss.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any party wishing to respond to Spire’s motion to dismiss shall do so no later than May 19, 2021.
