On November 1, 2005, Southern Missouri Gas Company, L.P. (SMGC), asked the Commission for a rule variance to offer its eligible customers a conversion incentive program in order to encourage conversion to natural gas. On November 9, 2005, SMGC filed its revised tariff pages making changes to its tariffs to expand the proposed "no charge" conversion policy and make the policy a permanent part of the tariffs. The effective date of the revised tariffs was December 9, 2005. On November 18, 2005, SMGC filed a letter extending the effective date of the revised tariffs to December 23, 2005.

The Commission will order its Staff to reply to SMGC's application and tariff revisions.
