There was usually discussion among the owners, developers and their consultants on their choice of heating energy. In all cases, KCPL provided rate schedules and, in some cases, actually did the rate calculation on whatever sources were being considered. In some cases the owner or his representative would want a comparison made of steam versus electric. In other cases the owner or his consultant would have pretty much made up their mind before we had an opportunity to have any input.
