Re: Notice of Termination of Transportation
Service Agreement Under Rate Schedule ITS

Gentlemen:


As you are aware, certain waivers were granted by FERC to permit interim open access transportation on the Williams Natural Gas Company system in Docket No. RP86-155. These waivers expire the earlier of May 1, 1987 or ten days after the FERC issues an order on rehearing of a stipulation and agreement in Docket Nos. RP86-32 and RP86-68. Further, Article VII, Government Regulations, of the Transportation Service Agreement between WNG and your company provides that in the event FERC does not issue any necessary certification or other necessary authorization acceptable to either party to provide transportation services thereunder, the Transportation Service Agreement may be terminated upon 30 days' prior written notice.

WNG will seek an extension from FERC to permit interim transportation to continue beyond April 30, 1987. Because WNG has no assurance at this time that it will continue to be able to provide transportation service beyond April 30, 1987, we find it necessary to inform you now of WNG's intent to terminate its arrangement(s) with you effective 7:00 a.m. CST May 1, 1987. As provided in Paragraph 11 of Rate Schedule ITS, Original Sheet No. 23, Volume No. 1 of WNG's FERC Gas Tariff, we will continue to work with you for the succeeding 45 days in order to bring the agreements into final and proper balance.

WNG is committed to the concept of open access transportation and is pursuing options which should result in full open access during 1987. Unfortunately, none of those options is sufficiently implemented to the point where continued service beyond April 30 is assured at this time. We will continue those efforts, however, and notify you as soon as reasonably possible of any changes.
