## APPLICATION TO INTERVENE OF NUCOR STEEL SEDALIA, LLC

COMES NOW Nucor Steel Sedalia, LLC ("Nucor"), pursuant to 20 CSR 4240-2.075 of the Missouri Public Service Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure and this Commission's March 14, 2022 *Order Giving Notice, Setting a Deadline to Intervene, and Directing a Proposed Procedural Schedule*, and for its Application to Intervene respectfully states as follows:

- 1. On March 11, 2022, Evergy Missouri West ("Evergy") filed a Petition requesting a financing order authorizing Evergy to finance qualified extraordinary costs that were incurred as a result of Winter Storm Uri in February 2021. As stated in the Petition, Evergy estimates such securitization "will provide quantifiable net present value benefits to retail customers" as compared to customary rate treatment for such costs.
- 2. Nucor owns a steel production facility in Sedalia, Missouri. Nucor takes electric service from Evergy pursuant to a special contract. Nucor uses electricity throughout its operations, but in particular, Nucor uses substantial quantities of electricity to melt steel scrap, recycling it to make new steel. The cost of electricity is critical to Nucor's competitiveness in the national and international steel markets. Nucor has an interest in this case because the outcome of the proceeding may have an effect on Nucor's costs and operations.

- 4. Nucor's intervention will serve the public interest by assisting the record for the Commission's decision in this case. Nucor continues to review Evergy's request, and at this time, Nucor is unsure of the positions it will take.
