ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO ACCEPT POST-HEARING EXHIBIT

On July 27, 2015, Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCPL") filed a Further Response to Commissioner Request for Information with the Missouri Public Service Commission, requesting that Attachment 4 to that filing be admitted into the record of the hearing. KCPL states that Attachment 4 contains information regarding customer satisfaction surveys responsive to inquiries by a Commissioner during the evidentiary hearing. More than ten days have elapsed, and no party has objected to the request.¹ The Commission finds the request reasonable and will grant it.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Kansas City Power & Light Company's motion to accept post-hearing exhibit, filed on July 27, 2015, is granted.
2. Kansas City Power & Light Company's Attachment 4, which is part of the Further Response to Commissioner Request for Information filed on July 27, 2015 and attached to this order, is marked as Exhibit 168 and admitted into the record of the hearing.
