**ORDER DIRECTING FILING**

On November 21, 2014, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (“Ameren”) filed an application to adjust its Energy Efficiency Investment Charge Rider. The Staff of the Commission filed its Recommendation on December 19, 2014, stating that the Commission should approve the tariff.

On December 30, 2014, the Office of the Public Counsel (“OPC”) filed a Motion to File Out of Time, Request for Additional Time to Respond to Staff’s Recommendation, and Motion to Suspend Tariff Sheets. OPC failed to state any legal authority that allows the Commission to suspend the tariff, and also failed to state how long it would like the Commission to suspend the tariff.

The Commission will order the parties to respond as follows.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. No later than January 5, 2015, the Office of the Public Counsel shall state what authority it believes the Commission has to suspend the tariffs, and shall state for how long it wishes the tariffs to be suspended.

2. The Staff of the Commission and Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri shall respond no later than January 9, 2015.

3. This order shall be effective when issued.
