**ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO FILE RECOMMENDATIONS
REGARDING TARIFF**

Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed a tariff revision on March 27, 2015, to amend its Energy Efficiency Investment Charge Rider tariff to implement a previously-approved exemption for qualifying low-income customers.¹ The tariff revision carries a May 27 effective date.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.093(4) requires Staff to file a recommendation regarding the tariff no later than thirty days after its filing. Thirty days after March 27 is April 26, which is a Sunday, meaning Staff's recommendation is due on Monday, April 27. The Commission will direct that any other party wishing to file a recommendation regarding the tariff do so by that date.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any party wishing to file a recommendation regarding Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri's revision to its Energy Efficiency Investment Charge Rider tariff shall do so no later than April 27, 2015.

¹ The exemption was part of a stipulation and agreement approved by the Commission on March 19, 2015, in Ameren Missouri's on-going rate case, ER-2014-0258.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
