**ORDER APPROVING TARIFF TO CHANGE
FUEL ADJUSTMENT CLAUSE RATES**

Issue Date: March 9, 2016

Effective Date: April 1, 2016

On February 1, 2016, Kansas City Power & Light Company (“KCP&L”) filed a tariff to adjust the company’s Fuel Adjustment Rates (“FAR”) pursuant to its Fuel Adjustment Clause (“FAC”). In accordance with KCP&L’s FAC, the proposed rate schedules are designed to recover from customers 95% of the change in fuel costs. The requested adjustments would increase a typical residential customer’s bill by approximately \$0.67 per month.

On March 2, 2016, the Commission’s Staff filed a recommendation. Staff verified that the actual fuel and purchased power costs, less off-system sales revenues, match the fuel and purchased power costs included in KCP&L’s calculated rates.

Based on the direct testimony of Linda Nunn, provided by KCP&L, and the recommendations of Staff, the Commission will approve KCP&L’s proposed rate schedule.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The rate schedule submitted by Kansas City Power & Light Company as Tariff No. JE-2016-0195, is approved as an interim rate adjustment, subject to true-up and prudence reviews, to become effective on April 1, 2016. The tariff sheet approved is:
