**ORDER APPROVING TARIFF TO CHANGE
FUEL ADJUSTMENT CLAUSE RATES**

Issue Date: May 11, 2016

Effective Date: May 25, 2016

On March 24, 2016, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, filed a tariff to adjust the company's Fuel Adjustment Rates ("FAR") pursuant to its Fuel Adjustment Clause ("FAC"). In accordance with the FAC, the proposed rate schedules are designed to recover from customers 95% of the change in fuel costs. The requested adjustments would decrease a typical residential customer's bill by approximately \$2.13 per month.

On April 25, 2016, the Commission's Staff filed a recommendation on the tariff. Staff verified that the actual fuel and purchased power costs, less off-system sales revenues, match the fuel and purchased power costs included in Ameren Missouri's calculated rates. Staff also reviewed Ameren Missouri's monthly interest rates that are applied to the under/over recovery of base fuel and purchased power costs for Accumulation Period 21, and verified that the monthly interest rates and calculations of interest amounts are correct.¹

¹ The amounts included in Ameren Missouri's fuel and purchased power adjustment include the true-up amounts for Recovery Period 18 (June, 2015 through January, 2016) currently before the Commission in File No. ER-2016-0244.

Based on the direct testimony of Erik C. Wenberg, provided by Ameren Missouri, and the recommendations of Staff, the Commission will approve Ameren Missouri's proposed rate schedule.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The rate schedule submitted by Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, as Tariff No. YE-2016-0245 is approved as an interim rate adjustment, subject to true-up and prudence reviews, to become effective on May 25, 2016. The tariff sheet approved is:
