The Empire District Electric Company filed the pending tariff on September 30.¹ No later than 30 days from that date, Staff's recommendation is due.² The Commission will set a date for filing a response to the recommendation.³ Parties to the general rate case in which the Commission approved the fuel adjustment clause are parties to this case without having to file an application for intervention.⁴ The Commission will direct its Data Center to add those parties to the service list. For anyone else, the Commission will set a deadline for filing an application to intervene.⁵ The tariff bears a proposed effective date of December 1, 2016.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any application for intervention shall be filed no later than October 11, 2016.
