<u>Surrebuttal Testimony of Keri Roth</u>	p. 4, lines 15-16	Q – <u>assumes facts not in evidence</u> - "Is there a sewer commodity rate stated in the current Missouri Public Service Commission (MPSC or Commission) approved tariff?"
	p. 5, line 3	<u>Offers a Legal Conclusion</u> - "... in violation of its tariff ..."
	p. 6, lines 20-21	Q – <u>assumes facts not in evidence</u> – "Does the aforementioned settlement agreement represent the current tariff on file?"
