MOTION FOR LEAVE TO DISMISS COMPLAINT

Complainant, the Missouri Propane Gas Association (MPGA), by and through undersigned counsel, and for its Motion for Leave to Dismiss Complaint, states as follows:

- 1. On November 9, 2018 MPGA and Summit Natural Gas of Missouri, Inc. (Summit) filed a non-unanimous stipulation and agreement. The stipulation and agreement resolved all of the issues remaining in the case, and stated that Summit will only convert propane appliances to natural gas appliances if the appliance manufacturer makes available a conversion kit. In addition, MPGA agreed to dismiss its complaint within five days of the Commission's approval of the stipulation and agreement.
- 2. On December 5, 2018, the Commission issued its Order Approving Stipulation and Agreement. The order became effective on December 15, 2018.
 - 3. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(1) states as follows:

An applicant or complainant may voluntarily dismiss an application or complaint without an order of the commission at any time before prepared testimony has been filed or oral evidence has been offered by filing a notice of dismissal with the commission. Once evidence has been offered or prepared testimony filed, an applicant or complainant may dismiss an action only by leave of the commission, or by written consent of all the parties.

4. Accordingly, MPGA requests the Commission's leave to dismiss the matter.

WHEREFORE, MPGA respectfully requests that the Commission grant MPGA leave to dismiss the complaint in this case.
