ORDER APPROVING TARIFF SHEETS

On May 2, 2006, Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, filed three tariff sheets to implement the Missouri Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) Incentive Grant Program, which is designed to support energy efficiency and environmental performance in the construction of Missouri buildings. This program is pursuant to the Commission's Report and Order Approving Stipulation and Agreement in Case No. EC-2002-1. Sections 7 and 11 of the Agreement provide for a Residential and Commercial Energy Efficiency Fund and for Collaborative Efforts to identify and fund programs which will promote residential and commercial energy efficiency in AmerenUE's service area.

On May 5, 2006, the Commission directed the Staff to file a recommendation regarding the tariff sheets. On May 22, the Staff filed its recommendation and memorandum recommending that the Commission approve the tariff sheets. The Staff stated that the tariff sheets are in compliance with the Commission's Report and Order issued in Case No. EC-2002-1.

The Commission has reviewed the tariff sheets filed by AmerenUE and the Staff's recommendation and memorandum and finds that the proposed tariff sheets should be approved to become effective June 1, 2006.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:
