**ORDER DIRECTING PARTIES TO FILE PROGRESS REPORT**

In its Report and Order in AmerenUE's most recent rate case, ER-2007-0002, the Commission ordered Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE to file a revised Industrial Demand Response tariff. AmerenUE filed its revised tariff on July 2, 2007, with a 90-day effective date of October 1. The Commission ordered its Staff to file a recommendation regarding AmerenUE's tariff no later than August 31. Other interested parties were allowed until September 10 to respond to Staff's recommendation, or to file a recommendation of their own.

Staff acknowledged that AmerenUE's tariff did not meet the expectations of some of the parties but recommended that the Commission approve the tariff because even a flawed Industrial Demand Response Tariff is better than no tariff at all. The Missouri Energy Group and the Office of the Public Counsel filed responses to Staff's recommendation. They object to AmerenUE's tariff in its current form, but indicate they are still negotiating with AmerenUE and anticipate that an acceptable revised tariff can be ready before the October 1 effective date of the current tariff. Public Counsel recommends

that the parties be directed to file a status report by September 19 to inform the Commission on their progress in negotiating the terms of a revised tariff.

Public Counsel's suggestion is reasonable and will allow the Commission sufficient time to act on AmerenUE's tariff before its effective date if the parties are not able to reach an agreement.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The parties to this case shall file a progress report no later than September 19, 2007, explaining their progress in negotiating the terms of a revised Industrial Demand Response Program Tariff.

2. This order shall become effective on September 11, 2007.
