**ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFF**

Issue Date: September 25, 2007

Effective Date: October 1, 2007

In its Report and Order in AmerenUE's most recent rate case, ER-2007-0002, the Commission ordered Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE to file a revised Industrial Demand Response tariff. AmerenUE filed its revised tariff on July 2, 2007, with a 90-day effective date of October 1.

Staff filed a recommendation regarding AmerenUE's tariff on August 31. Staff acknowledged that AmerenUE's tariff did not meet the expectations of some of the parties but recommended that the Commission approve the tariff because even a flawed Industrial Demand Response Tariff is better than no tariff at all. The Missouri Energy Group and the Office of the Public Counsel filed responses to Staff's recommendation. They objected to AmerenUE's tariff in its current form, but indicated they were still negotiating with AmerenUE and anticipated that an acceptable revised tariff could be ready before the October 1 effective date of the current tariff.

On September 19, AmerenUE filed a progress report indicating the parties continue to negotiate and will meet again on September 28. AmerenUE believes they will ultimately

reach an agreement regarding the tariff, but not before the tariff's October 1 effective date. For that reason, AmerenUE asks the Commission to suspend the tariff until November 1.

AmerenUE's request is reasonable and the Commission will suspend the tariff, as permitted by Section 393.150, RSMo 2000.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The tariff sheets issued on July 2, 2007, by Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, and assigned Tariff No. YE-2008-0005, are suspended for a period of 31 days beyond October 1, 2007, to November 1, 2007, or until otherwise ordered by this Commission. The tariff sheets suspended are:
