ORDER APPROVING EXPEDITED TARIFF

Issue Date: August 5, 2009

Effective Date: August 6, 2009

On July 23, 2009, Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE issued a tariff that would implement a residential price response pilot program to demonstrate application of a price response program for residential customers. The tariff will also allow AmerenUE to collect data for further evaluation and future design of such programs. AmerenUE's tariff carries an August 22 effective date, but along with its tariff, AmerenUE filed a motion asking the Commission to approve the tariff to take effect on August 6. AmerenUE explains that allowing the tariff to take effect early will allow the pilot program to operate during an extra two weeks of the summer cooling season.

The Commission's Staff filed its recommendation regarding AmerenUE's tariff on August 3. Staff advises the Commission to approve the tariff on an expedited basis so that the company will have an opportunity to evaluate the pilot program during peak summer usage events that are more likely to occur in August.

For good cause shown, as allowed by Section 393.140(11) RSMo 2000, the Commission will approve the submitted tariff sheets to take effect on less than 30-days notice.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The proposed electric service tariff sheets submitted under Tariff File No. YE-2010-0052 by Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, are approved, effective on and after August 6, 2009. The specific tariff sheets approved are:
