ORDER SETTING TIME FOR RESPONSES

Effective Date: February 4, 2020

On February 3, 2020, Spire Missouri Inc. (Spire Missouri), on behalf of its operating units, Spire Missouri East and Spire Missouri West, filed a request for waiver of the 60-day notice provisions of Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-4.017(1).¹ Spire Missouri indicated its intent to file its infrastructure system replacement surcharge (ISRS) cases in sixty days. On February 3, Spire also tendered its Verified Application(s) and Petition(s) of Spire Missouri, Inc. to Change its Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge for Spire Missouri East and Spire Missouri West.

In its request for waiver, Spire Missouri states that good cause to waive the rule exists for several reasons, inter alia because it has had no communication with the Commission within the prior 150 days regarding any substantive issues likely to be in this case outside of pleadings or other public communications.

The Commission will set a time for replies to the request for waiver.

¹ Spire Missouri cites to 4 CSR 240-4.017. The Commission will cite the applicable rules per the current numbering system.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any responses to Spire Missouri Inc.'s request for a waiver of Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-4.017(1) shall be filed no later than February 14, 2020.
2. This order is effective when issued.
