## ORDER DIRECTING EXPEDITED STAFF RECOMMENDATION AND SETTING TIME FOR ANY RESPONSES TO TARIFF FILING

On October 28, 2021, the Commission issued an order approving Spire Missouri Inc. d/b/a Spire's COVID-19 Residential Assistance Program tariff sheets for its Spire Missouri East and Spire Missouri West operations. On March 17, 2021, Spire filed a motion for expedited treatment and tariff revisions designed to extend the COVID-19 Residential Assistance Program an additional two months. The tariff sheets, which were assigned Tariff Nos. YG-2021-0170 and YG-2021-0171, bear an effective date of April 16, 2021, but Spire asks that the Commission approve the tariff revisions to be effective March 31, 2021, so that there is no gap in the COVID-19 Residential Assistance Program.

In consideration of the requested effective date of the tariff sheets, the Commission will direct the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission to file a recommendation on an expedited schedule. The Commission will also establish a deadline for any other entity to file a response to the tariffs.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than 3:30 p.m. on March 22, 2021, the Commission's Staff shall file a recommendation with regard to the revised tariff sheets filed by Spire, Tariff Nos. YG-2021-0170 and YG-2021-0171, and Spire's request for expedited treatment.

2. Any other person or entity wishing to comment on Spire's tariff revision or motion for expedited treatment shall file a response no later than 3:30 p.m. on March 22, 2021.

3. This order is effective when issued.
