On July 20, 2000, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company and SBC Advanced Solutions Inc. submitted to the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) modification а proposed to their interconnection agreement, previously approved in this case on October 7, 1999. On September 7, 2000, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed its recommendation which stated, inter alia, that the Staff believed the proposed modification did not conform to Section 252(i) of the federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 and thus opposed the approval of the proposed modification.

The Commission will convene a hearing on Wednesday, October 18, 2000, at 8:30 a.m. in Suite 310 (the large hearing room) in the offices of the Missouri Public Service Commission in Jefferson City, Missouri, located on the main floor of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street. The purpose of the hearing will be to acquire information from the parties regarding the proposed modification.
