ORDER CONCERNING PIPELINE REPLACEMENT PROGRAMS

The Commission's Staff (Staff) filed a motion to establish a docket for the Commission's acknowledgment and approval of certain pipeline replacement programs. This docket was established in response to that motion.

Pursuant to the Commission's rule, 4 CSR 240-40.030(15)(C), (D), (E), all known operators of natural gas systems in the State of Missouri have notified the Staff of whether their systems contain unprotected steel service lines and yard lines and cast iron and unprotected steel transmission lines, feeder lines and mains. Those operators having unprotected steel service and yard lines are required by the Commission's rule, 4 CSR 240-40.030(15)(C), to notify the Commission by May 1, 1990, which program of replacement of such lines the operator will choose.

Operators having cast iron transmission and feeder lines and mains are required by the Commission's rule, 4 CSR 240-40.030(15)(D), to submit to the Commission by May 1, 1990, their selected program for replacement of these lines and mains. Operators having unprotected steel transmission and feeder lines and mains are required by the Commission's rule, 4 CSR 240-40.030(15)(E), to submit to the Commission before May 1, 1990, their program for replacement or cathodic protection of these lines and mains. All known operators required to submit such proposed programs to the Commission have already done so.

The Staff recommends that the Commission issue an order finding that the following operators have indicated that they do not have pipeline material in their systems requiring them to submit programs pursuant to the Commission's rule, 4 CSR 240-40.030(15): City of Albany, Altenburg-Frohna Joint Utilities, City of

Berger, City of Bernie, City of Bethany, City of Bismarck, City of Clarence, City of Grant City, Greeley Gas Company, City of Green City, City of Hermann, City of Kennett Light, Gas & Water, City of Liberal, City of Macon, City of Madison, City of Mercer, City of Middletown, City of Milan, Missouri Pipeline Company, City of Monroe City, City of Montgomery City, City of New Florence, City of New Haven, City of Oronogo, City of Paris, City of Perry, City of Perryville, City of Plattsburg, City of Potosi, City of Princeton, St. Joseph Light & Power Company, City of Shelbina, City of Stanberry, and City of Unionville.

As requested in Staff's motion, the Commission notes that the above-listed operators have indicated that they do not have pipeline material in their systems requiring them to submit programs pursuant to the Commission's rule, 4 CSR 240-40.030(15).

Staff further moves that the Commission find that the following operators required by the Commission's rule, 4 CSR 240-40.030(15)(C), to choose a replacement option have done so: City of Albany, Altenburg-Frohna Joint Utilities, Associated Natural Gas Company, City of Bismarck, Bowling Green Gas Company, Greeley Gas Company, KPL Gas Service, City of Kennett Light, Gas & Water, Laclede Gas Company, City of Macon Municipal Utilities, Missouri Public Service, City of Paris, City of Perry, City of Plattsburg, City of Potosi, City of Shelbina, Union Electric Company and United Cities Gas Company.

As requested by the Staff the Commission finds that the operators listed in the previous paragraph have chosen a replacement option as required by the Commission's rule, 4 CSR 240-40.030(15)(C).

The Staff also moves that the Commission approve the pipeline replacement programs submitted pursuant to the Commission's rules, 4 CSR 240-40.030(15)(D) and (E), by the following operators: Associated Natural Gas Company, City of Bethany, Bowling Green Gas Company, Laclede Gas Company, Missouri Public Service, and City of Perryville.

As requested by the Staff the Commission will approve the pipeline replacement programs submitted by the operators listed in the previous paragraph pursuant to the Commission's rules, 4 CSR 240-40.030(15)(D) and (E).

The Commission will order its Staff to monitor the implementation of the programs approved in this order. The Commission advises these operators that should they believe that these programs require modification in the future, they will need to obtain the Commission's approval. Further, the Commission admonishes these operators that approval of their respective programs does not in any way release them from compliance with any other requirement of the Commission's rules.

The Commission notes that the replacement and protection programs of KPL Gas Service, Laclede Gas Company, Union Electric Company and United Cities Gas Company are being, or will be, monitored in whole or in part in separate dockets. The Commission further notes that the Cities of Granby and Springfield and the City of Fulton Municipal Utilities have been granted a stay of enforcement in circuit court from these requirements and, therefore, have not submitted programs pursuant to the Commission's rule, 4 CSR 240-40.030(15).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the pipeline replacement programs submitted by the operators of natural gas transportation systems in the State of Missouri pursuant to the Commission's rules, 4 CSR 240-40.030(15)(D) and (E), as listed in this order be approved hereby.
2. That the Commission's Staff be directed hereby to monitor the implementation of the programs approved herein.
3. That this order shall become effective on the 23rd day of April, 1991.
