NOTICE OF TARIFF FILING AND ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO FILE RECOMMENDATIONS

On October 25, 2011, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, filed tariffs designed to implement changes to its residential energy efficiency programs. Those tariffs carry a November 24 effective date. Ameren Missouri indicates the proposed tariffs are designed to bridge the gap between the expiration of its former energy efficiency programs, which expired on September 30, 2011, and the Commission's issuance of an order regarding Ameren Missouri's upcoming Missouri Energy Efficiency Investment Act (MEEIA) filing.

The Commission will provide notice of this tariff filing to the parties in Ameren Missouri's most recent rate case, ER-2011-0028, and to the parties in Ameren Missouri's pending Integrated Resource Plan (IRP) case, EO-2011-0271. In addition, the Commission will establish a date for the filing of applications to intervene, will direct its Staff to file a recommendation about the tariff, and will establish a date for the filing of recommendations by other parties.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Data Center shall send a copy of this order to all parties to File Numbers ER-2011-0028 and EO-2011-0271.

2. Any appropriate person or entity wishing to apply to intervene shall do so no later than November 9, 2011.

4. The Commission's Staff shall file a recommendation regarding Ameren Missouri's residential electric energy bridge tariffs no later than November 14, 2011.

5. Any other party wishing to file a recommendation regarding Ameren Missouri's residential electric energy bridge tariffs shall do so no later than November 14, 2011.

5. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
