ORDER DENYING REHEARING

On December 14, 2011, the Commission issued a notice in which it indicated its intent to take no action to suspend or reject a tariff filed by Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, to implement changes to its business energy efficiency programs. Subsequently, Ameren Missouri's tariff became effective by operation of law on its December 18 effective date. On December 23, the Office of the Public Counsel filed a motion asking the Commission to reconsider its December 14 notice regarding Ameren Missouri's tariff. The Commission denied that motion on January 4, 2012. On January 13, Public Counsel filed an application asking the Commission to rehear its order denying reconsideration.

Section 386.500.1, RSMo (2000), indicates the Commission shall grant an application for rehearing if "in its judgment sufficient reason therefor be made to appear." Public Counsel's application for rehearing merely restates positions the Commission has previously rejected. In the judgment of the Commission, Public

Counsel has not shown sufficient reason to rehear the Commission's order denying reconsideration. The Commission will deny the application for rehearing.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Public Counsel's Application for Rehearing is denied.
- 2. This order shall be effective immediately upon issuance.
