ORDER OPENING CASE TO CONSIDER TARIFF

On May 28, 2013, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (“GMO”) filed its 2013 Annual Renewable Energy Standard (“RES”) Compliance Plan and Report pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.100. The Commission assigned File No. EO-2013-0505 to that case.

On July 5, GMO filed a motion to approve a tariff and a motion for expedited treatment. GMO filed the motions and the tariff in File No. EO-2013-0505. The Commission ordered parties to file responses to the tariff and motion no later than July 30. The Commission received several responses that oppose GMO's requests.

The Commission will separate the solar rebate tariff from the RES case, and will create a new case for the tariff.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

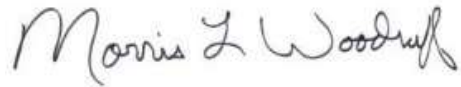
1. File No. ET-2014-0026 is opened.
2. All pleadings and motions concerning the solar rebate tariff shall be filed in

File No. ET-2014-0026, and not in File No. EO-2013-0505.

3. The Data Center shall remove Tariff No. YE-2014-0011, and the parties' motions and pleadings concerning Tariff No. YE-2014-0011, from File No. EO-2013-0505, and shall place them in File No. ET-2014-0026.

4. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
